Metropolitan Council And AFSCME Council 5, Local 668

Memorandum of Understanding

Whereas; the current Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the Metropolitan Council ("Employer") and AFSCME Council 5, Local 668 ("Union") will expire December 31, 2017.

Whereas; the parties intend to enter contract negotiations prior to expiration of the current CBA.

Whereas; the Employer and the Union have agreed to commit themselves to a productive and harmonious relationship before, during, and after contract negotiations.

Whereas; both parties are signatories to a letter of agreement (LOA) establishing pay for employees on the Union's negotiating team [page 38 of the 2016-2017 Collective Bargaining Agreement].

Whereas; the current LOA specifies that only two non-exempt employees from environmental services are eligible for pay.

Whereas; the parties agree that, for this round of negotiations, up to four non-exempt employees from Environmental Services will be compensated for time spent at negotiations during their regular work hours.

Now therefore be it resolved; the parties agree to amend the LOA to compensate up to four nonexempt employees from Environmental Services for time spent negotiating during their regular work hours. All other provisions in the original LOA remain in effect.
